# 1.2 Strength, Weakness, Opportunity and Challenges (SWOC)

### **Institutional Strength**

- 1. The peaceful atmosphere of the college makes the teaching-learning process more efficient.
- 2. Discipline among students is also a great strength of our college.
- 3. The college has good Student-teacher ratio with highly qualified and enthusiastic Faculty. Most of the faculties are young. Faculties are efficient enough in employing ICT aids for teaching-learning process.
- 4. The institution has sufficient area for further infrastructural growth.
- 5. The extension-services undertaken by the NSS & Rover-Ranger unit of the college prove to be beneficial for the students and to the neighbouring localities.
- 6. Sanitary pad disposal machine is also available for female students.
- 7. The college has also developed a herbal garden where different medicinal and herbal plants are growing.
- 8. The college also organises different skill development program for the benefit of student on collaboration with different departments and NGOs on regular basis.

## **Institutional Weakness**

- 1. The college is too far from the main town and also there is no regular transport available to reach the college.
- 2. Science block is not yet constructed in the college. So insufficient classrooms and inadequate infrastructure is also a big issue.
- 3. Proper playgrounds are not available for different games and sports activities.
- 4. The NCC unit has not yet started in the college.

## **Institutional Opportunity**

- 1. The College has sufficient area for infrastructural expansion viz., construction of Auditorium, Academic Blocks, Mini Stadium, Library etc.
- 2. The extra classes for students are beneficial for those preparing for competitive examinations and also for slow learners.

- 3. Regular conduction of workshops by the Career Counselling Cell provides an insight into various job-opportunities.
- 4. The various awareness programs organised by the anti-drug cell and disciplinary committee makes students aware about their well being.
- 5. The students also come to know about the benefits and growing method of local medicinal plants from the college herbal garden.
- 6. Interaction with local entrepreneurs makes the student aware about the career opportunities available in the localities.

#### **Institutional Challenge**

- 1. To motivate the local students to take admission in the college.
- 2. Due to the lack of sufficient infrastructure it is very difficult to conduct the classes properly.
- 3. To establish the NCC unit in the college.
- 4. Due to lack of proper ground it becomes difficult to conduct the sports activities.

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
